### Post Communion



Today is the centenary of the end of World War One. This anniversary and the events planned give opportunities to commemorate those who gave their lives, and to remember the challenges of living with the memory of war. Each of us has power to influence, and we have the chance to commit ourselves to work for peace and reconciliation between peoples.
