2023 Annual Report

2023 was our Silver Jubilee year! We celebrated in June by inviting our members to a very enjoyable Tea Party in the Oldham Hall.

The charity held many happy events in 2023:-

- "Tales from a Riverbank" talk by Jo Laurie in April.
- The AGM was held in the Parish Church on 22nd April.
- Silver Jubilee Tea Party in June, with live music.
- "Great Missenden Church School' Bi-Centenary" talk by Paula Kitching, a Trustee, in September.
- Tabletop sales by the Library in June, October and December
- Attendance at the Church School Summer Fair in July and the School Christmas Fair in November, with preserves.
- Attendance at Sunday afternoon Cream Teas at the Parish Church raised £1889 from sales of Preserves.
- Participation in the Holy Trinity Church Bazaar in Prestwood in November.
- The Christmas Tree Festival over two days, with preserves, gifts and books raised over £1000.
 Maurice Taylor's five large wooden church models were displayed in the Lady Chapel, representing the building's development from its foundation in AD 1133.

Income: £14,648 was raised in 2023 thanks to our excellent Committee, kind members and supporters. Local shops and businesses have kindly helped again with publicity, raffle prizes and other support. We are most grateful for all this fundraising help. The Co-op, Oasis, Papillon, Big Sky and Prestwood Garage have given raffle prizes and Samways are always happy to sell tickets for our events. A Sum-up bank card reader was purchased in April and contributed nearly £1,000 in online sales. Sales of preserves, some cakes and gifts raised £7085. Fruit and sugar donations and the Eco-friendly re-cycling of jam jars and lids were greatly appreciated!

Easyfundraising donations have raised £304. More supporters would help to raise free donations from online shopping at over 8000 brands. There is no cost to the user and when £5 has been raised easyfundraising will double it. https://www.easyfundraising.org.uk/causes/fogreatmissparch

Grants to the PCC totalled £11,212 in 2023: £4720 for the third tranche of stonework repairs to the Tower and south wall; £5892 for repairs to the church boiler which should extend its life by 16 years; and £600 for the regular annual gutter and downpipe maintenance and cleaning, to prevent water ingress and damage to interior wall plaster.

The **Quinquennial Inspection** took place in August 2023.

Membership now totals145. Several new Friends were welcomed in 2023, including Missenden Abbey as a corporate member. We sadly lost several members, including John Martin, our former excellent Treasurer for three years. We record their kind support of our charity over the years. New members are always warmly welcomed and are necessary to build up funds for future repair and restoration grants to the PCC. Our current fundraising mission is "Raise the Roof Campaign".

Your Committee members work hard and continue to contribute many excellent fundraising ideas. They, and a few friends, very kindly contribute all the delicious food for our events, free of charge. Norma Gardner stepped down in November after nine years as a trustee and Nevil Coulson, our Treasurer, steps down at the AGM on 11th May 2024 after seven years in post. Their work and support have been invaluable and have greatly helped the charity. Nick Moss was welcomed to the Committee as Assistant Treasurer in September 2023 and will be formally elected Treasurer at the AGM.
